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**A BILL**

To provide for fiscal accountability for new direct funding under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act by converting its direct funding into authorizations of appropriations and by rescinding unobligated direct funding.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Healthcare Fiscal Ac-  
5 countability Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONVERTING PPACA DIRECT FUNDING TO AUTHOR-**  
2 **IZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS AND RE-**  
3 **SCINDING UNOBLIGATED PPACA DIRECT**  
4 **FUNDING.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
6 sion of law, for each provision described in column 1 in  
7 the table specified in subsection (b), the following rules  
8 shall apply:

9 (1) DIRECT APPROPRIATIONS.—

10 (A) CONVERSION TO AUTHORIZATIONS OF  
11 APPROPRIATIONS.—For each such provision  
12 that provides for a direct appropriation of funds  
13 for fiscal year 2012 or a subsequent fiscal year  
14 and for which special rule #1 or special rule  
15 #2 does not apply under column 3 of such  
16 table, such appropriation is deemed only to be  
17 an authorization of appropriations and amounts  
18 are available under such provision only pursu-  
19 ant to appropriations made after the date of the  
20 enactment of this Act.

21 (B) RESCISSION OF UNOBLIGATED APPRO-  
22 PRIATIONS.—Of the funds available pursuant to  
23 a direct appropriation under such provision for  
24 which special rule #1 or special rule #2 does  
25 not apply under column 3 of such table, the un-  
26 obligated balance is rescinded.

1 (2) FUND TRANSFERS.—

2 (A) CONVERSION TO AUTHORIZATION OF  
3 TRANSFER SUBJECT TO APPROPRIATIONS.—For  
4 each such provision that provides for a transfer  
5 of funds for fiscal year 2012 or a subsequent  
6 fiscal year, such transfer is deemed only to be  
7 an authorization of such transfer in such  
8 amounts as are provided in advance in appro-  
9 priations acts enacted after the date of the en-  
10 actment of this Act.

11 (B) RESTORATION OF TRANSFERRED  
12 FUNDS.—Amounts transferred under such pro-  
13 vision which have not been obligated as of the  
14 date of the enactment of this Act shall be re-  
15 stored to the Trust Fund or other fund from  
16 which they were transferred.

17 (3) SPECIAL RULES.—

18 (A) SPECIAL RULE #1 FOR CERTAIN EX-  
19 TENSIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS BEGINNING  
20 AFTER FISCAL YEAR 2011.—For each such pro-  
21 vision for which column 3 of such table specifies  
22 that special rule #1 applies, the amendment (or  
23 amendments) made by the section in column 2  
24 is repealed and such provision is restored as if  
25 PPACA had not been enacted.

1 (B) SPECIAL RULE #2 FOR CERTAIN EX-  
 2 TENSIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS BEGINNING BE-  
 3 FORE FISCAL YEAR 2012.—For each such provi-  
 4 sion for which column 3 of such table specifies  
 5 that special rule #2 applies—

6 (i) the amendment (or amendments)  
 7 made by the section in column 2 is re-  
 8 pealed and such provision is restored as if  
 9 PPACA had not been enacted, except that  
 10 such repeal shall not apply to fiscal year  
 11 2010 or fiscal year 2011; and

12 (ii) of the funds available pursuant to  
 13 the operation of such amendment (or  
 14 amendments) for fiscal year 2010 or fiscal  
 15 year 2011, the unobligated balance is re-  
 16 scinded.
